## First ever FDR ready mixed style demo in Ohio

The Clinton County Engineer in conjunction with SW Ohio Concrete, Hanson and Southeastern Equipment hosted a FREE demonstration showing the value of Full Depth Reclamation (FDR) Ready Mixed Style on Tuesday, May 17th in Clinton County, OH.

Despite the rain, the demonstration attracted a fairly decent crowd. Nearly 100 industry personnel were registered for the event, including county and municipal engineers, consultants and ready mix producers who learned about this new and innovative technique to address road repair problems.

This was the first time that this process, using ready mix supplied grout, was used in Ohio.

The live demonstration took place on Haley Road just north of Sabina Road in Northeastern Clinton County, OH. Using a BOMAG™ reclaimer to prepare the road, along with a sheepsfoot roller and ready mix delivered grout, attendees witnessed first-hand how a moderately used road can be rehabilitated to achieve a mid-range fix at a fraction of the average road repair cost.

Along with the rehabilitation the road was widened from 17 feet to 19.5 feet making it more suitable for handling wider farm equipment.

With the exception of the operation of the BOMAG™ Reclaimer, all of the equipment was operated by county personnel allowing them the opportunity to self-perform on future projects. BOMAG™ supplied the operator and another expert to help educate the county people on this process.

A special thanks to Lehigh Cement who supplied the cement for the grout, Holcim who supplied the Grandcem™ and Hanson who supplied the grout to make this demonstration a success.
