Description – The Federal Highway Administration is offering a 1-day workshop to highway agencies covering the benefits of a good Quality Assurance program and how it can be used to increase the longevity of concrete pavements. This can be accomplished through a focus on quality in the constructed product. It will emphasize that everyone must understand their roles and impacts on the overall quality of pavement. This effort will benefit everyone involved in the project, both in a global sense and a personal sense. This is not a workshop about the details of Quality Assurance. It is a practical overview of what leads to increased quality with real world examples based on input from state DOTs, academia, industry representatives and contractors.

Who Should Attend? – Local agency employees, state DOT personnel, FHWA personnel, engineering consultants, contractors and materials suppliers, technicians, and others involved in the QA process for construction of concrete pavements.
