Ohio Concrete has identified a huge need for qualified drivers; they recognize the training need and have partnered with Lorain County Community College to deliver the training program. Through Ohio Concrete, all members coordinate efforts in handling problems of common concern. They protect and advance the interests of the industry. These partners have collaborated to create a Ready Mix Concrete Truck Driver Training Program.

The purpose of the program is to train individuals who hold a current CDL Class B minimum with no air brake restrictions license to operate Ready Mix Concrete Trucks.

Curriculum:

• Concrete 101 • Safety • Ready Mix Truck Driving Requirements and Restrictions • Knowing Your Truck & Required Daily Maintenance • Driver Operations at the Plant, On the Job & End of Day • Assessment.

The Training Program is short-term, just 20 hours. The program applies to seasoned professionals as well as less experienced drivers and allows participants to learn more about the technical aspects of the ready mix industry, profession, and customer service skills.

Specific knowledge gained from this course includes:

handling, placing, curing and testing concrete; operating a ready mix truck, and mixer; required daily procedures: Lock out/Tag out, proper equipment, and ventilation, loading and unloading.

Drivers who successfully complete the program will receive a certificate from Lorain County Community College and Ohio Concrete. Graduates will be provided employment assistance through Ohio Concrete and Lorain County Community College. Graduates will be entered into the association database to aid in connecting employers with a qualified workforce.



Employment is expected to grow 6 percent in the next five years; there is an aging workforce that continues to support the need for "Certified Concrete Truck Drivers."
