Introduction to Political Action Committees

- A political action committee is a combination of two or more persons, the primary or major purpose of which is to support or oppose any candidate, political party, or issue.
- The PAC is funded by voluntary contributions from individuals and other PACs. PACs can accept contributions from LLCs, but corporate contributions are prohibited.
