## Golf Outing Requirements and Recommendations

With the recent change in golf course operating procedures, the following guidelines will need to be followed to ensure the health and safety of all players, guests, and staff members at the Medallion Club. We will operate in accordance with the Golf Industry guidelines provided by the State of Ohio and will recommend best practice procedures where applicable.

### Best Practice Recommendations:

- Convert shotgun starts to tee times. Being a 27-hole facility, we are able to accommodate up to 156 players in a block of tee times that span 1 hour and 48 minutes. So if your first tee time is at 10am, the final players would tee off at 11:48am
- Require players to arrive no earlier than 45-minutes before their tee time to stagger arrivals.
- Restructure after golf programming to allow players to eat with their group and then leave the property. Raffle items or door prizes can be drawn while golfers are on the golf course and players can pick up prizes after they finish. Scoring will be digital and a link can be provided for players to stay updated on the leaderboard via their smartphone. Events with an auction may want to consider providing participants the option to view/participate in the auction or programming via Facebook Live or a similar platform

### Required by all events:

- Social distancing must be maintained at all times. This includes during registration, in the cart staging area, practice facilities and during F&B events before or after golf.
  - If a shotgun start is chosen for the event, social distancing requirements may not permit the use of the driving range or putting green before play as those areas are large gathering points for golfers. Tee time starts will stagger arrival times and limit the number of people in those areas at any given time.
- Registration needs to be outside the building, allowing golfers to avoid coming in the club house should they choose to do so
- Food stations on the golf course are not allowed. If lunch is part of the event, Medallion staff members will deliver boxed lunches to the golfers on the golf course at a time determined by event organizers.
- On-course contests (long drive, long putt, closest to pin, corn-hole, etc) are not permitted at this time. These create additional touch points that are not allowed.
  - Mulligans, "string", or other games that are sold to individual groups are permitted as they are just used by golfers in their own group

- Flag sticks must remain the holes. Cups are equipped with the EZ Lyft System to allow for touchless retrieval of golf balls. All on course touch points such as water coolers, bunker rakes, and ball washers have been removed.
- Vendors, spectators, or volunteers are not allowed on the golf course.
- We have 90 carts available for golfers. Each group will be limited to 2 golf carts. If a player does not feel comfortable riding in a cart with another person due to health concerns, we can offer a single rider cart as long as we have supply to do so. Players in this situation will be required to pay an additional cart fee for the single rider cart. If we do not have any more carts available, we will provide a push cart free of charge or they are welcome to walk with their bag riding on a cart in their group. We cannot guarantee single rider carts for all players.
- We will enforce any face mask requirements required by local authorities. While not currently mandated, if they are required come the day of the event, we will require masks be worn on property. Should the outing choose to mandate masks for all participants, we will support that policy.

The Medallion Club staff is taking every precaution to keep our members, guests, and staff safe during these times. This includes but is not limited to reduced capacity in common areas, one way traffic, increased spacing in staging area and driving range, frequent cleaning and sanitizing of common touch points, and masks (and gloves when necessary) worn by staff at all times.
