OTHER PERTINANT INFORMATION: Please have your workbook with you during the review course along with the linked review session worksheet. Your instructor will advise each person as to individual exam schedule for the following day so you will know if you are starting at the Wellness Center for the written exam or Moritz Concrete for the performance exam.

Lunch will not be provided. There will be a lunch break for you to purchase food at nearby locations, or you may bring a packed lunch with you.

Basic calculators for standard mathematical functions (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division) are permitted. However, programmable calculators and smart phones will be prohibited during testing.

Individuals are required to wear proper personal protection equipment (PPE) when taking the performance examination. Proper PPE includes safety glasses, gloves, long pants (no shorts), and safety work shoes (steel toed preferred-no flip flops, sandals, crocs, tennis shoes or dress shoes). Not having proper PPE could result in the registrant not being allowed to take the performance exam.

WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER THE PROGRAM: ACI (not Ohio Concrete) will send your test results to the email address you provide on your written exam about 2-3 weeks after the program. Be sure to check your junk folder as these results often land there.

Should you fail the written portion, but pass the performance, you have one year from the testing date to retake the written without having to retake the performance exam. The same is true should you fail the performance exam but pass the written. Please note: There is a charge for re-exams.

CANCELLATION POLICY: All cancellations are subject to a \$15 processing fee. Cancellations must be made at least 7 days prior to the start of the class to receive a refund. “NO SHOWS” will be charged full registration fees. No credits will be carried over to next year. A late fee of \$15 will be assessed for those registering within 7 days of the examination. Classes are subject to cancellation based on the number of registrants. Registrants will be notified at least one week prior to the start of the course of any cancellations or changes. Course fees are subject to change.
